We would like to bring to your attention that the Alpha Magnetic Spectrometer (AMS) Collaboration has several new potential members that should be reviewed for Export Control Compliance. The Chinese (or China) Academy of Space Technology (CAST) was represented by Professor Hou Zengqi and Professor Zhang Jiaxun at the last AMS Technical Interchange Meeting. CAST will be working with the Thermal Control System team on the Tracker Thermal Control System. The Chilean Nuclear Energy Commission was represented by Dr. Leopoldo Soto. In addition, Mr. Klaus Von Storch, a Chilean astronaut represented Ingeniero Aero Espacial. It is not clear what, if any, role the Chileans will play in the AMS collaboration.
