The payload has also been reviewed by the Department of Commerce and has been categorized 1A999 (see CCATS# G026926), which allows free distribution of data to foreign nationals of all countries apart from North Korea, Syria, and Sudan. All data included in this package has been reviewed and found to be in the public domain.

The AMS-02 SDP does not contain any proprietary material that requires special handling controls.
